# **Engine and Powertrain**

- **Engine Oil and Filter**: Checked oil levels; oil is clean and at optimal levels. No signs of contamination or leaks detected.
- **Cooling System**: Radiator and coolant levels inspected; coolant at proper levels, with no leaks or blockages found in the system. Fan and belts are in good condition.
- **Air Filter**: Inspected primary and secondary air filters; both are clean and functional with no need for immediate replacement.
